WINTER TIP

With the chill in the air, it's not only the time of year to winterize our homes and cottages but to also winterize our golf equipment. It is the time of year to take the right steps to store our golf wear and clubs.

Here are a few tips for storing your clubs until spring returns:

Thoroughly clean your golf clubs. A bucket of warm soapy water and a clean rag are all you will need. Make sure to completely dry the clubs before putting them back into your golf bag.

A good idea is to soak them for a few minutes and clean the heads with a toothbrush. This will help to get the dirt out of the grooves on each club.

Clean the shaft and grips on your clubs

as well making sure to dry off before storing.

This is a good time to see if you are in need of repairs or replacements since the off season is the best time to have them refitted.

Now let's clean out your golf bag:

Replace old or worn out golf gloves.

Replace the cleats on your golf shoes that are worn or missing.

Shine your shoes if they need it and replace worn laces.

Inventory your golf balls and clean them off as well as your golf tees.

To keep your golf bag smelling fresh while in storage, throw in a dryer sheet over the winter months.

Where do I store my clubs?

The clubs should be kept in a warm, dry place.

Don't keep your clubs in the garage unless it's heated, and don't put them in your basement if it is at all damp.

Keep your clubs away from humidity to avoid rust.



When spring returns be ready to hit the driving range and your clubs will also find their mark.
